The Lancaster High School Boys Soccer Team finished a successful season Saturday with a 3-0 loss to Pickerington North. The Team accomplished a winning record (8-7-1) for the first time since 2001. It is only the second winning record for the program since 1998. The Gales beat Pickerington Central (1-0) for the first time since 1981 and defeated Hilliard Darby (3-0) for the first time ever. Additionally the Boys boosters defeated Newark for the first time since 2002 (8-0). Individually Matt Clouston led the team with 10 goals and 22 points. Jacob Lang and Devin Schoonover were team leaders with 5 assists. Kenny Green tallied 7 shutouts on the season and had a 1.55 goals against average. The 7 shutouts is a school record for one season. The Gales also excelled in the classroom with Green earned Academic All-OCC and Academic All-Central District.
